Supervisory scheme information

The legal basis for the supervisory activities are Regulation (EU) No 910/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 July 2014 on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market and repealing Directive 1999/93/EC,

Implementing body

In accordance to Article 17(1) of Regulation (EU) No 910/2014, Article 4, paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Croatian implementing act designate the central government body responsible for the economy as the supervisory body.

In accordance to Article 22(1) of Regulation (EU) No 910/2014, Article 4, paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Croatian implementing act designate the central government body responsible for the economy as the body responsible for the establishment, maintenance, and publication of Croatia's trusted list.

The Service for digital economy is the organizational unit of the Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development, designated as the contact point for all matters regarding trust services, supervision, and the trust list.
